

concrete timbre composers, musicians, multimedia artists, and actors collaborate to create
a fantasia with a heartbroken ironworker grieving after the death of his three children. An
aged and forgetful Saint Peter appears looking for his lost keys to heaven, but can't
remember the way back to the gates. They set out on a quest through phantasmagorical
landscapes encountering various mythological, fairytale and literary saga characters
traveling through Europe, South America, the Himalayas, Africa, and the middle East.

Keys to Heaven features a new translation in a multimedia setting with original video
projections, live performance of a new original music score and electronic soundscape
that completely underscores the text, however is not sung. Rather than relegating the
music and soundscape to the background, it is a partner to the text and actor who elevate
and intensify their voices speaking the dialogue in a heightened style, somewhat
indicative of opera.
